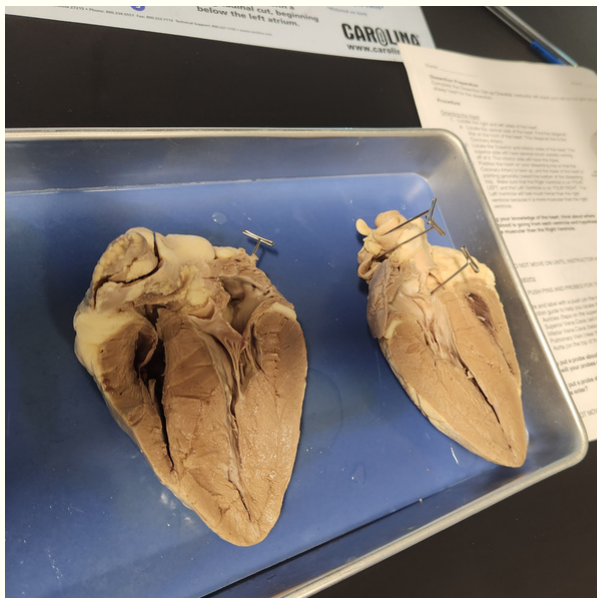
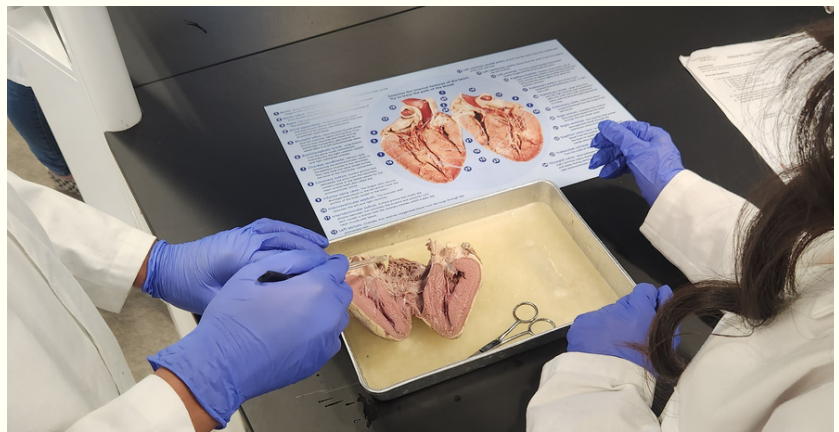
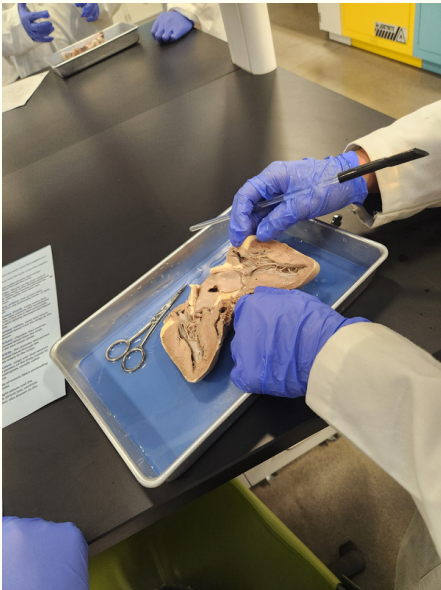






# CLASSROOM SPOTLIGHT
