We are back into the rhythm with our academics and activities happening on campus.

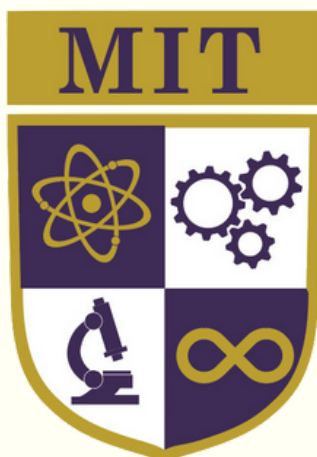

# ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY – UNIVERSAL LEARNER COURSE VIA AP LITERATURE

We are very proud and happy to announce the launching of MIT's first Universal Learner Course through Arizona State University!

IPI 194 serves as an advanced research elective 3-credit course at the provost level, through Open Citizen –

"OpenCitizen is a program structure in which groups or individuals use an open-inquiry process to identify needs (social action, community needs, personal goals, learning goals, etc), research them, and plan and follow through with meaningful action and outcomes." –OpenCitizen is a collaboration among ASU Interplanetary Initiative, ASU Learning Enterprise, and Beagle Learning, Inc.

We would like to thank our ELA Department Chair and AP Literature teacher Mr. Morganstern for bringing this program to MIT and providing another opportunity for our students towards their college readiness.

This is what Mr. Morganstern has shared about this initiative.

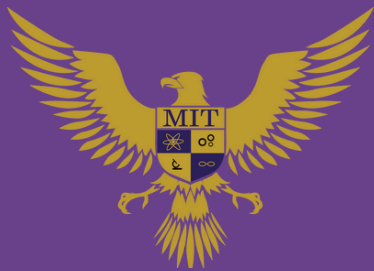
"To gear this type of course to AP Literature, something not traditionally STEMM, proved to be a challenge. Understanding my students and their skills needs for our AP Lit. course, I thought this would be a great opportunity for them to grow their skills in writing the essays required for their exam, and specifically allow them a better chance to score higher. The project will help them take a Universal Theme of their interest from a work of literary merit, also of their choosing, and build connections to their community that they will then incorporate into their Free Response Question #3 on the AP Lit. Exam, with the hopes of earning the AP Analysis Rubric Row C Point for Sophistication revolving around a deeper more complex discussion outside of the referenced text. I hope to help facilitate more ULCs through ASU and OpenCitizen that are open to all courses of study at MIT in the very near future!" – Mr. Morganstern
