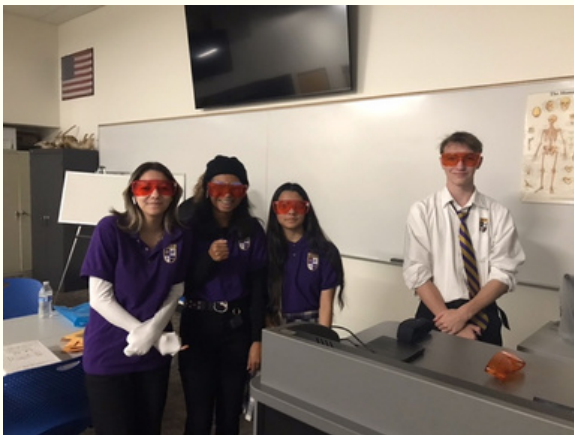
PEER TUTORING BY NHS MEMBERS

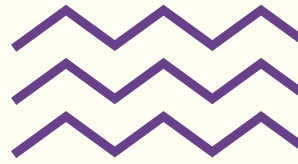
You will need the doctor to complete the approved CAA 2023-2024 physical form. This form can be found on the MIT athletics website under the tab called "Registration".
